The main text of the case begins with 'The respondent had been entrusted with the care of the child ('deceased'), aged two years and seven months. On 13 June 2018, the deceased, who was not well at the material time, was sent to the respondent's house together with his brother. While there, the deceased cried continuously and when the respondent's attempts to stop the deceased from crying failed, the respondent showed a green chilli to the deceased to scare the deceased. When the deceased continued crying, the respondent popped the green chilli into the mouth of the deceased when his mouth was gaped open as he was crying. This caused the deceased to have difficulty to breathe. The respondent tried to give some water but the deceased could not swallow the water and was hence, rushed to the clinic and subsequently to the hospital. The deceased passed away despite the attempts to treat him. The post mortem report showed that the cause of death

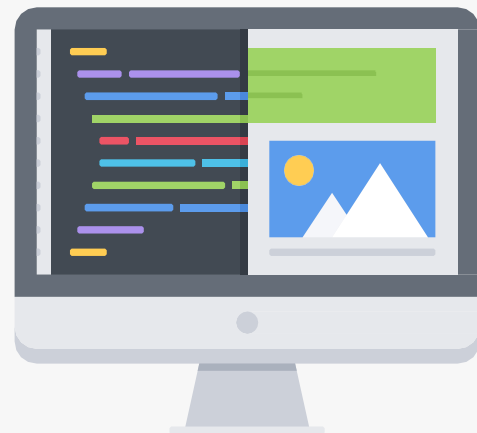
