

# Diploma Pengurusan Maklumat:

## PERJALANAN 20 TAHUN DI BUMI KENYALANG



Pada bulan November 2003, lembaran sejarah mengukir satu bab baru dengan penubuhan program Diploma Pengurusan Maklumat di UiTM Sarawak.

Bermulanya penubuhan Diploma Pengurusan Maklumat di UiTM Sarawak adalah merupakan hasil permintaan daripada Kerajaan Negeri Sarawak pada masa itu. Sebelum penubuhannya, jumlah profesional dan pegawai separa profesional di bidang pengurusan maklumat agak terhad. Melalui perbincangan yang panjang dan penuh semangat antara pihak Fakulti Pengurusan Maklumat dan pihak pengurusan UiTM Sarawak, satu keputusan besar telah dilahirkan. Ia bukanlah sekadar impian, tetapi sebuah realiti yang akan membawa impak yang jauh ke hadapan. Program Diploma Pengurusan Maklumat akan menjajakan kaki di kampus UiTM Sarawak.

Pada bulan November 2003, lembaran sejarah mengukir satu bab baru dengan penubuhan program Diploma Pengurusan Maklumat di UiTM Sarawak. Bermula dengan 2 orang pensyarah sebagai peneraju, iaitu Puan Suriani binti Jack dan Encik Albakri bin Mohammad, program ini telah membuka pintu kepada 12 orang pelajar pertamanya. Sepanjang perjalanan, program ini tidak pernah berhenti tumbuh. Dengan setiap semester yang berlalu, menyaksikan pertambahan yang mengagumkan dalam bilangan pelajar dan pensyarah yang terlibat. Hingga ke hari ini, fakulti dengan bangganya mempunyai purata 300 pelajar setiap semester, yang turut disertai oleh barisan pensyarah yang penuh dedikasi.

Selama dua dekad yang lalu, program ini telah menjadi tempat kelahiran lebih dari 2000 graduan. Mereka bukan sekadar meninggalkan bangku kuliah, tetapi membawa bersama mereka semangat kegigihan untuk menyumbang kepada masyarakat. Sebahagian besar dari mereka telah memenuhi keperluan penting pegawai separa profesional dalam Kerajaan Negeri Sarawak serta di pelbagai sektor swasta. Mereka bukan sahaja menjadi penggerak pertumbuhan ekonomi, tetapi juga membawa cahaya harapan kepada komuniti di sekitar mereka. Namun, kejayaan ini tidak berhenti di situ. Banyak daripada graduan kita telah terus memperdalam ilmu mereka, mengejar pendidikan ke peringkat yang lebih tinggi.

Kini, mereka berdiri teguh di pelbagai jawatan di agensi kerajaan dan syarikat swasta di seluruh negara, membuktikan bahawa tiada yang dapat menghalang mereka untuk mencapai cita-cita yang lebih tinggi. Di sebalik setiap kejayaan, terdapat sentuhan nasihat dan dorongan 14 orang pensyarah tetap di fakulti ini. Mereka bukan hanya pengajar, tetapi mentornya juga. Mereka memberi galakan, membina visi, dan mengilhami generasi baru untuk menerajui cabaran masa depan dengan keyakinan dan keberanian.

Tidak dilupakan penubuhan Persatuan Pengurusan Maklumat (INFORMS), sebuah entiti yang muncul dari semangat dan cita-cita, menawarkan medan untuk pelajar Diploma Pengurusan Maklumat meluahkan kreativiti dan kebolehan mereka. Dengan perlu dedikasi, mereka merancang dan melaksanakan pelbagai aktiviti kurikulum yang menarik dan bermakna. Cerita kebangkitan INFORMS terukir indah. Ia bukanlah sekadar hasrat, tetapi nyata hasil dari desakan dan keinginan para pelajar untuk menyertai perjalanan yang lebih bermakna di luar dinding-dinding kuliah.

Namun, INFORMS tidak hanya sekadar sebuah persatuan. Ia adalah suara yang bergema di koridor-koridor kampus, mewakili dan menghubungkan para pelajar dengan dunia akademia di fakulti. Dengan peranan yang dinamik, INFORMS menjambatani jurang antara pelajar dan pihak pengurusan, memastikan setiap suara didengari dan setiap keperluan dipertimbangkan. Di tengah-tengah kepelbagaiannya aktiviti dan sumbangannya kepada komuniti, INFORMS sentiasa konsisten aktif ke arah pertumbuhan dan kecemerlangan. Ia adalah simbol kekuatan kolaborasi dan jalinan antara pelajar-pelajar untuk mencapai kejayaan.

Sepanjang 20 tahun penubuhannya di bumi kenyalang, pelajar dan pensyarah di fakulti ini bukan sahaja menyumbang kepada kecemerlangan akademik universiti. Mereka juga banyak melibatkan diri dalam aktiviti memperkasa dan mempromosi keperluan serta pengurusan maklumat di kalangan masyarakat. Dengan kerjasama yang kukuh diantara persatuan serta agensi lain di negeri Sarawak, banyak perubahan di peringkat masyarakat telah dilakukan. Antaranya penambahbaikan dan penubuhan perpustakaan komuniti di lokasi yang memerlukan serta aktiviti celik maklumat yang sering diadakan.

Seiring berlalunya 20 tahun, fakulti ini telah menyaksikan gelombang perubahan yang melanda pelbagai aspek pengurusannya. Yang terkini adalah satu keputusan besar telah diambil: nama Fakulti Pengurusan Maklumat diubah kepada Pusat Pengajian Sains Maklumat. Ia bukan sekadar satu perubahan kosmetik, tetapi satu langkah yang mendalam bagi kami memahami evolusi dan keperluan semasa dalam bidang yang semakin berkembang ini. Dengan nama baru ini, kami membawa harapan yang baru. Harapan untuk mencapai kecemerlangan dalam ilmu pengetahuan dan inovasi. Harapan untuk terus mengejar aspirasi dan inspirasi dalam menyumbang kepada masyarakat melalui ilmu sains maklumat. Semoga nama baharu ini menjadi titik tolak untuk penghayatan yang lebih mendalam, penyelidikan yang lebih bermakna, dan pencapaian yang lebih gemilang di masa hadapan. Bersama-sama, kami menghadapinya dengan semangat yang tidak padam dan membawa fakulti kepada kejayaan yang lebih cemerlang di masa-masa akan datang.

Barisan pensyarah Pusat Pengajian Sains Maklumat dan Fakulti Perakaunan bersama Timbalan Rektor (Akademik & Antarabangsa) UiTM Sarawak

Fakulti Perakaunan dan Pusat Pengajian Sains Maklumat telah mengadakan sesi perjumpaan bersama Profesor Madya Ts. ChM Dr Mohammad Isa Bin Mohamadin, Timbalan Rektor Hal Ehwal Akademik dan Antarabangsa bertempat di Bilik Mesyuarat Utama, Universiti Teknologi MARA (UiTM) Cawangan Sarawak Kampus Samarahan, Pada 13 Oktober 2023 hari Jumaat, pukul 2.00 petang

Antara tujuan perjumpaan ini diadakan adalah untuk memberi peluang dan ruang kepada para pensyarah Fakulti Perakaunan dan Pengajian Sains Maklumat untuk menyuarakan pendapat, persoalan dan mengetengahkan permasalahan yang berkaitan dengan pengurusan program akademik masing-masing. Antara masalah yang dibincangkan termasuk yang berkaitan dengan akses kepada Sistem Maklumat Pelajar untuk kemudahan Penasihat Akademik, proses pendaftaran kursus pelajar, kemudahan pengajaran dan pembelajaran bilik kuliah, pengambilan pensyarah sambilan dan sebagainya. Setiap masalah tersebut dijawab dengan penuh hikmah oleh Profesor Madya Ts ChM Dr Mohammad Isa bin Mohamadin dengan fakta dan maklumat yang lengkap.

Pengacara majlis pada hari tersebut ialah Puan Siti Maliza Binti Haji Salleh, pensyarah kanan dari Fakulti Perakaunan. Rata-rata semua pensyarah Pusat Pengajian Sains Maklumat hadir dalam perjumpaan kali ini. Dalam ucapan aluan dari Profesor Madya Ts ChM Dr Mohammad Isa Bin Mohamadin, beliau menekankan bahawa tanggungjawab dan amanah sebagai seorang pensyarah kini berubah dan tidak hanya tertakluk

Pada 8 Disember 2023 hari Jumaat, seramai 10 orang pensyarah Pusat Pengajian Sains Maklumat, UiTM Cawangan Sarawak Kampus Samarahan yang diketuai oleh Dr Susan Hydra Sikayu selaku Ketua Pusat Pengajian (Perakaunan dan Pengajian Sains Maklumat) telah membuat kunjungan hormat dan sesi perkongsian ilmu bersama barisan pengurusan tertinggi yang diketuai oleh Puan Levas anak Mejus selaku Pengarah Perpustakaan Tun Abdul Rahman Ya'kub (PeTARY), Universiti Malaysia Sarawak. Antara tujuan utama kunjungan hormat ini diadakan adalah untuk untuk membincangkan peluang kolaborasi yang boleh diwujudkan antara Pusat Pengajian Sains Maklumat, UiTM Cawangan Sarawak dengan Perpustakaan Tun Abdul Rahman Ya'kub (PeTARY), Universiti Malaysia Sarawak (UNIMAS) terutama yang melibatkan perkongsian ilmu melalui forum dan konferensi dalam bidang sains maklumat. Program ini bertempat di Bilik Mesyuarat, Perpustakaan Tun Abdul Rahman Ya'kub dan dihadiri seramai 10 orang barisan pensyarah dari Pusat Pengajian Sains Maklumat, UiTM Cawangan Sarawak dan 5 orang pengurusan tertinggi Perpustakaan Tun Abdul Rahman Ya'kub yang terdiri daripada Puan Levas anak Mejus (Pengarah PETARY), Haji Valentino Bin Abu Bakar (Timbalan Pengarah), Encik Zaiden Bin Sanyut (Ketua Penolong Pengarah), Puan Norazlina Binti Abdul Rahman (Ketua Penolong Pengarah), Encik Abdul Rahman Bin Mohammad Hussain (Pembantu Pustakawan) dan Cik Norlia Binti Ismail (Setiausaha Pejabat)



Para pensyarah PPSM menggunakan kenderaan masing-masing dan tiba awal beberapa minit sebelum program bermula. Rata-rata para pensyarah PPSM merasa teruja dengan program ini dan mengharapkan agar program ini memberikan hasil yang positif untuk mencapai matlamatnya. Meskipun terdapat beberapa pensyarah lain tidak dapat hadir akibat kekangan masa dan pertindihan dengan program lain, hasrat program ini kendatipun kekal diteruskan. Tepat pukul 3.00 petang, delegasi PPSM UiTM Sarawak telah mengambil tempat duduk masing-masing untuk mendengar apa yang akan disampaikan. Program ini dimulakan dengan ucapan selamat datang delegasi PPSM oleh Haji Valentino selaku pengacara majlis pada petang itu. Seterusnya, majlis diteruskan dengan menjemput Puan Levas untuk memulakan dengan ucapan aluan.

#### Intipati ucapan Pengarah PeTARY:

- Pihak PeTARY giat dalam Menjalankan program berdasarkan komuniti selaras dengan agenda kebangsaan terutama berkaitan dengan literasi maklumat
- Pihak PeTARY kini berusaha untuk mengenalpasti mereka yang pakar dalam bidang sains maklumat dan jenis sumbangan yang dapat diberikan oleh pakar ini.
- Pihak PeTARY memberi penekanan kepada program kolaborasi bersama agensi luar tentang pembangunan sumber maklumat terutama kepada golongan kurang upaya
- Pihak PeTARY memberi perhatian khusus kepada program peningkatan tahap kompetensi pustakawan sesuai dengan perubahan minat dan kecenderungan pengguna masakini
- Pihak PeTARY mengalakkan lebih banyak program berbentuk webinar untuk mengetengahkan isu berkaitan dengan sumber akademik
- Pihak PeTARY ingin melihat lebih ramai penglibatan aktif penyelidik muda bagi merancakkan industri yang berterusan digital.

Seusai ucapan yang disampaikan oleh Dr Susan tersebut, majlis kemudiannya diteruskan dengan sesi Taklimat yang disampaikan oleh Haji Valentino Bin Abu Bakar. Berikut adalah ringkasan taklimat tersebut:

Sesi taklimat yang disampaikan oleh Haji Valentino ini sedikit sebanyak telah menunjukkan bahawa PeTARY memberikan komitmen yang berterusan dalam memastikan setiap daripada program yang dirancang adalah bertepatan dengan keperluan semasa demi mendepani cabaran masa depan terutama dalam memastikan peranan perpustakaan akademik kekal relevan untuk memenuhi hasrat dan aspirasi samada di peringkat negeri, negara maupun antarabangsa.. Program diteruskan dengan sesi perbincangan antara kedua belah pihak tentang program dan aktiviti yang berpotensi untuk berkolaborasi.

Rumusan kepada sesi perbincangan tersebut adalah pihak PeTARY menunjukkan minat untuk berkolaborasi dalam pengajuran Borneo International Information Science Symposium (BIIS) dengan mencadangkan agar satu Jawatankuasa Kerja diwujudkan antara kedua dua belah pihak untuk pengurusan symposium ini dan satu mesyuarat khas perlu dibuat tahun 2024.

Antara perkara lain yang turut disentuh ialah tentang usaha PPSM untuk menawarkan program sedia ada iaitu Ijazah Sarjana Muda (Kepujian) Pengurusan Rekod ke UiTM Cawangan Sarawak di mana penjelasan ini telah disampaikan sendiri oleh Ts Dr Mohd Rafiz Bin Salji selaku penyelaras IM261 tersebut untuk makluman lanjut pihak PeTARY. # Techtome Explorers

Bridging Knowledge Gaps and Fostering Digital Literacy

The Techtome Explorers program, organized by the final-year students of class IMI10 5C pursuing a Diploma in Information Management, unfolded as a one-day initiative to provide exposure and insights into science management. The program involved one project advisor and 21 students who diligently worked to enhance information skills, promote digital literacy, and underscore the evolving significance of libraries in the digital era.

The Techtome Explorers program embraced three primary objectives. Firstly, it sought to provide children at Pusat Jagaan Nur Murni exposure to Information Science and information skills that apply to primary and secondary school learning. Secondly, the program aimed to offer guidance on the importance of digital literacy in information search for the children at Pusat Jagaan Nur Murni. Lastly, it intended to develop and improve a mini reading corner for Pusat Jagaan Nur Murni residents.

The program received an enthusiastic response from the residents of Pusat Jagaan Nur Murni, with 38 participants actively participating in the various activities. Despite initial challenges, meticulous planning and collaboration among committee members ensured the program's success. The caretakers expressed gratitude for choosing Pusat Jagaan Nur Murni for the program, highlighting the positive impact on the children's happiness and their increased awareness of information-related skills.

# KARNIVAL KITA

Pelajar tahun akhir ber ‘Karnival Kita’ di Kampung Gedung, Simunjan

Seawal jam 6 pagi pelajar tahun akhir dari kumpulan IM1105A telah mempersiapkan segala kelengkapan peralatan dan barang-barang untuk di bawa ke bas yang telah sedia menunggu di hadapan Pusat Pelajar. Segala persiapan telah dibuat dari seawal semester lagi, akhirnya Kg. Gedung di pilih bagi memenuhi keperluan kursus Extension Services for Information Agencies (IMD314). Program ini dijalankan selama dua hari dengan diiringi pensyarah Dr. Hjh. Imilia Ibrahim dan saya sendiri, Cik Suhaida Halamy. Perjalanan ke Kg. Gedung mengambil masa selama satu jam setengah dari UiTM Samarahan. Keheningan pagi yang mendamaikan membuatkan perjalanan kami tidak terasa apabila sampai ke destinasi tepat pada masanya.

Berkampung di hari minggu Sabtu dan Ahad, pada 16 sehingga 17 Disember 2023, adalah tarikh di mana program bersama komuniti penduduk kampung dilaksanakan. Pelajar menamakan program ini ‘Karnival Kita’ bersesuaian dengan aktiviti-aktiviti yang dijalankan. Seramai 29 pelajar terlibat dalam mengendalikan karnival ini, dengan masing-masing telah diberikan tugas dan tanggungjawab yang perlu dilaksanakan. Objektif program ini antaranya adalah untuk mewujudkan pemikiran kritis dan kreatif di kalangan penduduk kampung tidak kira latarbelakang dan umur dengan pelbagai aktiviti yang disediakan.

Bas berhenti menuju ke persinggahan pertama iaitu di homestay, penginapan pelajar bagi menurunkan beg dan barang-barang peribadi. Seterusnya kami di bawa menaiki bas dan terus ke Dewan Datuk Patinggi Ali, di mana lokasi karnival dijalankan. Dewan ini sangat luas dan merupakan dewan terbuka yang dikelilingi dengan kedai makan dan pelbagai fasiliti lain disediakan. Tiba

di dewan, bahang panas makin terasa sedang pelajar sibuk mengeluarkan kelengkapan dan barang-barang program dari bas untuk di bawa ke dewan. Kelihatan juga pelajar yang mengemas dan menyapu dewan bagi membuat persediaan memulakan aktiviti. Ada penduduk kampung yang sudah datang dan tidak sabar untuk bersama pelajar melakukan aktiviti.

Selesai mengemas dan mempersiapkan dewan, kira-kira jam 9.30 pagi, kaunter pendaftaran dibuka bagi penduduk kampung membuat pendaftaran pertandingan dan aktiviti-aktiviti yang disediakan. Kebanyakkan ibu-bapa mendaftarkan anak-anak mereka bagi pertandingan Info Hunt, membina origami, kitar semula kraf fun, reka bentuk buku dan lain-lain lagi. Aktiviti yang paling mendapat sambutan adalah pertandingan mewarna, Info Hunt, futsal, bola jaring dan Open Mic. Pelajar sangat teruja apabila penyertaan mendapat sambutan yang sungguh hangat dari penduduk kampung.

Pertandingan Info Hunt merupakan aktiviti pertama yang dimulakan pada jam 10.30 pagi. Sebanyak 6 kumpulan dipertandingkan dan fasilitator di kalangan pelajar dibahagikan kepada setiap kumpulan. Peserta perlu mencari klu di setiap enam check point yang disediakan. Kumpulan pertama yang berjaya memenuhi semua klu adalah dikira sebagai pemenang. Penyertaan pertandingan Info Hunt adalah terbuka, tiada had umur ditetapkan. Maka setiap kumpulan terlihat bercampur-campur dari segi umur dan jantina. Cabaran demi cabaran terpaksa diharungi apabila cuaca semakin panas kerana

check point diletakkan di kawasan-kawasan berasingan jauh dari lokasi dewan. Hampir jam 12 tengahari pertandingan Info Hunt tamat, dan kumpulan pemenang dikenal pasti.

Hari pertama, 16 Disember, diteruskan dengan jamuan makan tengahari. Setelah itu, persediaan diteruskan untuk aktiviti pada jam 2 petang. Sebanyak 4 pertandingan disediakan iaitu pertandingan mewarna, membina origami, kitar semula kraf fun dan reka bentuk buku. Semua aktiviti ini dijalankan serentak dan pada masa yang sama, jauh diseberang jalan adalah aktiviti melukis dan mengecat mural di Perpustakaan Awam Desa Kg. Gedung sedang dimulakan. Suasana riuh hiruk pikuk memenuhi suasana dewan dengan gelak ketawa kanak-kanak, ibu bapa dan penduduk kampung. Ketika aktiviti pertandingan ini sedang berlangsung, beberapa pelajar pula ditugaskan untuk menghias dewan dan di bantu oleh beberapa anak muda dari Kg. Gedung bagi acara malam kebudayaan pada sebelah malam. Aktiviti pertandingan berakhir dalam jam 4 petang dan aktiviti seterusnya jam 4.30 petang adalah perlawanan futsal dan bola jaring. Perlawanan futsal diadakan di gelanggang futsal tidak jauh dari lokasi dewan manakala bola jaring diadakan di dalam dewan. Perlawanan sungguh sengit di antara pasukan, di mana masing-masing menunjukkan semangat kesukanan untuk menang. Pemenang perlawanan ditentukan

dan kesemua aktiviti selesai dalam jam 6 petang. Seterusnya, para pelajar pulang ke homestay bagi mempersiapkan diri untuk aktiviti malam kebudayaan.

Malam menjelma, pelajar bersiap cantik dan anggun dengan kostum mengikut tema masing-masing iaitu Classic Rock and Retro. Kerusi telah disusun dan dewan telah dihias cantik, PA sistem telah bersedia untuk mengalunkan alunan muziknya. Penduduk kampung sedikit demi sedikit datang memenuhi ruang dewan. Mereka sangat teruja apabila nombor cabutan bertuah diberikan. Acara malam kebudayaan dimulakan pada jam 8.30 malam. Pengacara pada malam itu, saudara Max dan saudari Ainaa, menjemput penduduk kampung dan mengucapkan selamat datang kepada semua yang hadir. Open Mic diadakan pada malam itu yang merupakan acara nyanyian terbuka untuk penduduk kampung. Acara ini mendapat sambutan hangat dari orang dewasa sehingga kanak-kanak. Kebanyakkan persembahan adalah nyanyian dari pelbagai genre kecuali satu penyertaan adalah tarian Nopeng yang klasik. Semua yang hadir sangat terhibur dengan acara Open Mic dan ada yang bernyanyi bersama-sama dengan peserta.

Acara yang ditunggu-tunggu seterusnya adalah cabutan bertuah. Penduduk kampung bersorak gembira apabila nombor mereka disebut untuk hadiah cabutan bertuah. Tidak dilupakan juga, persembahan kemuncak pada malam itu diakhiri dengan tarian oleh pelajar-pelajar IM1105A. Usai acara malam kebudayaan dalam jam 11 malam, penduduk kampung bersurai ke rumah masing-masing dan pelajar pulang ke homestay. Malam masih muda, tiba di homestay, semua bersedia untuk berBBQ pula. Masing-masing berbual dan bergurau sesama mereka, mengenang kembali aktiviti-aktiviti yang dijalankan di siang dan malam hari. Akhirnya kesemua pelajar masuk ke bilik dan ke katil dalam jam 2.30 pagi.

Seawal jam 6 pagi, 17 Disember, para pelajar telah bersedia membuat persiapan bagi aktiviti yang akan dijalankan. Pelajar kemudian dibahagikan kepada dua kumpulan. Aktiviti diteruskan dengan menyudahkan aktiviti mengecat mural di Perpustakaan Awam Desa Kg. Gedung oleh kumpulan 1. Cuaca yang semakin panas, membuatkan aktiviti mengecat mural agak mencabar pada pagi tersebut. Manakala, kumpulan 2 ditugaskan untuk menyediakan sudut bacaan di Pusat Ekonomi Digital (PEDI) Kg. Gedung. Dua rak kayu disediakan dan buku-buku hasil derma dari para pelajar sendiri diletakkan di pusat tersebut. Kemudian, aktiviti diteruskan dengan pelajar dipecahkan kepada kumpulan-kumpulan kecil bagi memulakan sesi temu bual bersama orang kampung tentang aktiviti kehidupan, ekonomi, pendidikan dan sosial di kampung tersebut.

Jarum jam menunjukkan hampir ke jam 11 pagi, aktiviti diteruskan dengan sesi forum yang bertajuk Mendepani Cabaran Penipuan di Media Sosial. Penduduk kampung mengambil tempat di dewan bagi mendengar sesi forum yang berlangsung. Panel forum terdiri daripada saya, Cik Suhaida, pensyarah dan dua wakil pelajar iaitu Saudari Ainaa dan Saudari Bibiana, manakala Dr. Hjh Imilia pula selaku moderator. Tajuk forum yang dipilih merupakan isu yang kerap berlaku sekarang telah berjaya menarik minat penduduk kampung bagi mereka menambah ilmu pengetahuan dan mempunyai kesedaran apabila menggunakan media sosial.

Selesai sesi forum, acara diteruskan dengan upacara penutup dan penyampaian hadiah bagi aktiviti-aktiviti yang telah dijalankan pada hari pertama. Ucapan kata-kata aluan dimulakan oleh Encik Asri bin Bakri, wakil Presiden Gedung Unity dan juga wakil penduduk Kg. Gedung.

# BENGKEL ENDNOTE:

## Cara Mengelakkan Plagiarisme

EndNote merupakan suatu perisian yang bertujuan untuk mengurus dan menyimpan data bagi penghasilan bibliografi. Bibliografi ini penting bagi memudahkan para akademik, penyelidik, dan pelajar dalam mengurus dan menghasilkan senarai rujukan yang digunakan dalam setiap kajian. EndNote ini mempunyai pelbagai gaya dalam penghasilan senarai rujukan, antaranya American Psychological Association (APA), Modern Language Association (MLA), Turabian, Scientific, dan lain-lain.

Pada 4 Disember 2023, jam 2 petang, seramai 22 orang pelajar berkumpul di Makmal Komputer 6, Blok C, UiTM Kampus Samarahan. Para pelajar ini merupakan pelajar semester 1 yang mengambil kod kursus IMC111 Introduction to Information Skills. Subjek ini mendedahkan para pelajar mengenai betapa pentingnya untuk mempunyai kemahiran dalam pencarian maklumat yang efektif dan efisien. Di dalam subjek ini, didebak juga dengan penggunaan EndNote bagi memudahkan para pelajar dalam menguruskan dan menghasilkan senarai rujukan.

Program ini juga merupakan aktiviti wajib bagi para pelajar semester 1 untuk mengetahui bagaimana untuk menggunakan aplikasi EndNote secara efektif dan efisien, supaya mereka dapat menggunakan kemahiran ini dalam setiap tugas atau kajian yang diberikan oleh para pensyarah dengan mudahnya dalam menghasilkan senarai rujukan yang berkenaan dengan kajian mereka.



Program ini dimulakan dengan pengenalan kepada plagiarisme oleh En. Dominic Inggu. Beliau merupakan pembantu pustakawan kanan yang mempunyai pengalaman dalam mengajar aplikasi EndNote ini. Plagiarisme ini perlu dibendung sejak mereka di semester 1 lagi, dengan memberi pengenalan, jenis, dan cara mengatasinya. Bagi mengelakkan perkara ini terus terjadi dan semakin berleluasa, maka inisiatif dari perpustakaan yang mengetengahkan penggunaan EndNote ini perlulah disanjung tinggi bagi mengekalkan kualiti kajian para akademik, penyelidik, dan pelajar. Justeru, para pelajar semester 1 perlu

mengeksport hasil carian pangkalan data untuk perisian, antaranya EndNote, RefWorks, ProCite, dan lain-lain. Kelihatan para pelajar berasa teruja sepanjang bengkel ini diadakan dengan ilmu yang dikongsi oleh penceramah berkenaan penghasilan senarai rujukan daripada aplikasi EndNote.

Justeru, dengan adanya aplikasi EndNote ini, membolehkan para pelajar menghasilkan senarai rujukan mengikut format bibliografi yang tertentu mengikut keperluan silibus yang telah digariskan. Di samping memudahkan dalam

Aktiviti hands-on dimulakan dengan meminta para pelajar untuk memuat turun dan memasang perisian EndNote di dalam komputer riba masing-masing bagi memudahkan penggunaan perisian ini. Aktiviti diteruskan dengan mengenalkan pangkalan data yang telah dilanggan oleh UiTM, di mana para pelajar diminta untuk memuat turun data .RIS (Research Information Systems). RIS ini adalah format biasa yang digunakan untuk

mencari dan memuat turun sumber rujukan dari pangkalan data atau katalog perpustakaan secara automatik. Bengkel ini menjadikan para pelajar memahami kepentingan dalam membuat sitasi yang betul dan teratur mengikut format dan jenis yang tertentu dan sekaligus mengelakkan daripada berlakunya plagiarisme. Diharapkan dengan adanya bengkel seperti ini, para pelajar dapat memahami dan menitikberatkan betapa pentingnya mengadakan sitasi yang betul dari sumber yang dipercayai.

# BENGKEL PENGKATALOGAN:

Teknik Perekodan Bahan Menggunakan Sistem WiLS

Secara teorinya para pelajar akan mempelajari subjek IMD223: Introduction to Cataloging semasa mereka di semester 4. Subjek ini boleh dikatakan sebagai ‘killer subject’ bagi sesetengah pelajar. Mungkin mereka merasakan sukar dalam memahami dan mempelajari kemahiran menggunakan standard yang dikhususkan untuk membuat pengkatalogan deskriptif. Maka, pada 5 Januari 2024, hari Jumaat yang barakah, telah diadakan satu Bengkel Pengkatalogan bertempat di Bilik IT, PTAR Kampus Samaraham 2, khususnya untuk merekod bahan perpustakaan dengan menggunakan sistem WiLS. Bengkel ini telah dihadiri oleh 17 pelajar, 6 orang pensyarah dari Pengajian Sains Maklumat, dan beberapa staf perpustakaan sebagai penceramah dan fasilitator.

Jam 1.30 petang, pelajar dan pensyarah pengiring, Puan Nurfaizah Kamarudin dan Cik Nor Hayati Kassim bergerak ke PTAR KS2 dengan

menaiki bas UiTM. Perjalanan yang tidak mengambil masa yang lama, memudahkan pergerakan kami dari KS ke KS2. Setibanya di PTAR KS2, kami diarahkan untuk pergi ke Bilik IT. Bengkel dimulakan pada jam 2.30 petang dengan taklimat yang disampaikan oleh Encik Mohamad Ismail Bolia, Pembantu Pustakawan Kanan Tertinggi, dan Cik Commelie Elmlie Risip, Pembantu Pustakawan. Seusai taklimat, Cik Commelie Elmlie meminta sebaris pelajar untuk ke hadapan bagi ‘hands-on’ penggunaan sistem WiLS (Web-based Integrated Library System) dari LIBSYS. Sedikit sejarah sistem yang digunakan oleh PTAR, SISPUKOM dimulakan pada 1993, manakala ILMU pada tahun 1997, dan kini WiLS menggantikan ILMU pada tahun 2017.

Aktiviti ‘hands-on’ ini diadakan secara berkumpulan bagi mendedahkan para pelajar dan pensyarah bagaimana untuk merekod bahan dengan menggunakan sistem yang digunakan oleh PTAR keseluruhannya. Cik Commelie Elmlie membawa buku-buku, antaranya buku yang



# A GLIMPSE INTO Archival Practices:

## Visit to Sarawak State Repository

On December 8, 2023, a group of 49 students from Class 5A and 5D, accompanied by two IMD313 (Foundation of Archives) lecturers, Miss Suhaida binti Halamy and Miss Nor Hayati bte Kassim from the School of Information Science, embarked on an academic journey to the Sarawak State Repository. The primary focus of this visit was to provide students with a hands-on experience of the activities within archival institutions, going beyond the boundaries of theories learned within the classroom.

Prior to the academic visit, a comprehensive safety briefing ensured the well-being of both students and lecturers during the visit. The State Repository staff, led by Miss Dorothy, warmly welcomed us and provided an overview of the functions of the state

repository. She emphasized the repository's pivotal role in maintaining, preserving, and safeguarding public records in Sarawak aged over twenty-five years, as well as other documents, papers, instruments, statutes, statutory orders, regulations, or decrees, as directed by the State Secretary. These materials were deemed crucial for their historical value or public importance.




The journey began in the Document Preparation room. Here, two skilled staff members demonstrated the intricate steps in preparing documents before their permanent transfer to the repository. The time-consuming process, taking several hours for each document, was explained in detail. Students were introduced to the various tools used in processing records, including folders, acid-free tape, brushes, and paper irons. The students, captivated by the live demonstration, expressed their excitement at witnessing the process firsthand. They admired the staff's dedication and patience in handling these materials. It was revealed that processing a single folder could take up to 23 hours, highlighting the meticulous nature of archival work.

The educational journey continued in the Digitization Room, where records in the archive significantly transformed from physical to digital format. Students were

intrigued by having the opportunity to use the microfilm readers, a technology that excited their curiosity. The staff explained the microfilm creation process, giving students a unique opportunity to experience the darkness of the "Bilik Gelap" or dark room. Inside this room, illuminated only by a single red lamp, the staff detailed the fascinating process of producing images on microfilm. Before the end of the visit, we were brought to the Conservation Unit, where students were introduced to the cutting-edge Bio-fumigator machine. This machine is pivotal in eliminating harmful insects and microorganisms from records, requiring a 22-hour-long process. Students were also exposed to and demonstrated the 14-step conservation process. This process aims to maintain and repair the physical condition of documents, ensuring that the content is preserved for future generations.

After the visit, the students gathered to share their thoughts and experiences. The consensus was unanimous – the visit to the Sarawak State Repository had been nothing short of informative. Students expressed their amazement and excitement at learning in a real-world environment rather than within the confines of classroom walls. Some students even voiced their interest in pursuing careers within archival institutions. The visit to the Sarawak State Repository successfully bridged the gap between theory and practice, providing students with invaluable insight into archival practices and fostering a deep appreciation for the dedication of archival professionals in safeguarding our collective history.

The archive, in response, required an official letter and email. Motivating the students, I guided them through the paperwork, emphasizing the importance of completing it diligently. After assisting in refining the paperwork and TAPA form, the final step involved submitting the documents to the Academic Affairs Department (HEA) for approval. Moving one step closer to unlocking the doors of the National Archive of Malaysia, Sarawak Branch, for an enriching academic experience.





On the crisp Friday morning of December 1, 2023, our journey into excursion began as 33 students and two lecturers gathered at Parking A, UiTM Sarawak, in the early hour of 6:45 a.m. Meanwhile, the other six students steered their way to the archives on their vehicles. With the air filled with excitement, the bus wheels started to roll promptly around 7 a.m., marking the beginning of our excursion. Students were treated to breakfast, fostering a communal spirit as we embarked on the journey, which took approximately 1 hour and a half to reach our destination. Fortunately, luck was on our side, and the journey was free from the grip of traffic jams. As a result, we arrived at the National Archives of Malaysia right on schedule. Miss Nor Hayati and I were excited because it was our first time visiting the new and beautiful National Archives of Malaysia, which is more spacious than before.

The National Archives of Malaysia staff greeted us with cheerful smiles as we stepped through the entrance at 8:30 a.m. Their warm welcome set the tone for a delightful visit. Lecturers were requested to fill out the guest book indicating the arrival of the academic visit from the School of Information Science, UiTM Sarawak. Before diving into the excursion, we were served breakfast by the host. This visit was attended not only by Miss Nor Hayati and myself but lecturer Ts. Abdul Ismail Mohd Jawi also joined us, generously dedicating time to be part of this educational excursion.

As we savored our morning meal, we engaged in friendly conversations with staff members who joined us. The exchange of stories and laughter over breakfast created a sense of friendship, turning the visit into more than just an educational excursion; it became a shared experience, blending learning with the joy of connecting with the people behind the archives. Regrettably, our timing was not in sync with the schedules of the Director and Deputy Director, who were away attending an event in Kuala Lumpur during our visit. However, stepping into the spotlight were the gracious hosts for the day, Encik Fiqri Mohamed and Puan Suria Ismail, who seamlessly took on the responsibility of guiding and entertaining the students. Despite the absence of the higher-ups, their passion and knowledge infused the visit with an unexpected charm, turning what could have been a setback into an opportunity for a unique and enriching experience.

The curtains of the program lifted, and we were ushered into the main hall, Dewan Puspawangsa. The resonant chords of the national anthem, Negaraku, and Ibu Pertutiku, filled the air, accompanied by the soulful doa recitation. The collective spirit of unity was echoed in the pledge recitation by Encik Awang Umar Awang Hambali. The student representative, Cik Nurul Farhana Muhammad Mahazir from IM1105C, took the stage, weaving words of inspiration and purpose in a speech that set the tone for the unfolding

journey. We were treated to insightful briefing sessions and a delightful exchange of souvenirs between the National Archives of Malaysia and the School of Information Science, UiTM Sarawak. The MC, Puan Nurul Safiqahrina bt Bujang, gracefully conducted the program in the hall.

After that, Puan Suria took the stage, immersing us in a captivating briefing on the intricate world of records and archives management within the halls of the National Archives of Malaysia. She elaborates on procedures that unfolded from the transfer of archival materials, their meticulous management, storage, and onward to the crucial aspects of maintenance and preservation. The narrative she painted detailed the journey of these historical treasures, navigating from their origins in creating agencies to their ultimate sanctuary at the National Archives of Malaysia. Stepping into the limelight after Puan Suria, Encik Fiqri took the stage, unraveling the intricacies of OFA and COMPASS. In a masterful display, he briefed us on these tools and embarked on hands-on tutorials, igniting the students' excitement to explore COMPASS firsthand. Encik Fiqri, with his wealth of knowledge, concluded the tutorial sessions with a vibrant Q&A. This interactive session left the students feeling enriched and empowered with a deeper understanding.

The adventure continued as the students were divided into two groups. Encik Fiqri guided the IM1105B students, while Puan Suria led the IM1105C group. Both groups explored the Reference Area and Preservation and Conservation Area. They introduced the students to the Reference Area, deemed the most crucial space for researchers. Here, they access manual finding aids and online resources. However, there is a limitation as only one computer is available for researchers to use OFA and COMPASS. Through my excursion in this area, I found the old pictures of places in Sarawak hanging on the wall fascinating, although some needed captions or descriptions. Encik Fiqri also showcased several frequently requested old documents, like newspapers, posters, letters, and archives, in a special format, offering a glimpse into the historical richness stored in the archives. The reference area provides a spacious and comfortable environment for researchers to conduct their studies.

The most thrilling part was the Preservation and Conservation Area. But before that, we visited the Working Area, where the staff, Encik Modir Saard Saruji and Puan Rosnah Anak Renggan, demonstrated the cleaning process for documents being transferred from creating agencies to the National Archives of Malaysia. Once the cleaning

is complete, the documents are sorted into two categories. Records in good condition, without any issues, are transferred to the repository. On the other hand, documents with conditions or infections are moved to the Preservation and Conservation Area. Encik Kennedy Anak Nyadang demonstrated traditional tissue repair techniques to the students in this area. He introduced the tools required for these procedures. The procedures involved in preservation and conservation were highly technical, demanding meticulous care and patience. I observed students keenly interested, posing numerous questions to Encik Kennedy. Their curiosity delved into the finer details of the preservation and conservation techniques applied to archival materials.

As the visit neared its conclusion, the students were not ushered to the repository area this time. The staff explained that the area was

undergoing maintenance and not in proper order. Despite this detour, the immersive exploration of the Reference Area and Preservation and Conservation Areas provided the students with more than enough satisfaction and valuable insights. For many students, this marked their inaugural visit to the National Archives of Malaysia, Sarawak Branch. The hope is that this experience will enrich their understanding of classroom teachings and instill practical knowledge. Beyond merely for enjoyment or exam preparation, the visit aims to impart skills and insights they can readily apply in their future endeavors. It's not just about learning; it's about living the knowledge, touching history, and embracing the essence of the archive.

# INDUSTRIAL TRAINING BRIEFING:

*Opportunities  
and challenges*

As students, the most common way for them to acquire knowledge is through classroom instruction and occasionally through online techniques. Learning takes place not only in the classroom but also outside of it. On Friday, December 15, 2023, the faculty members gave the students a briefing on industrial training. This briefing aims to explain the information that is important to them before they begin their internship.

Puan Nurfaizah Kamarudin presented the briefing to about one hundred students at 2:30 p.m., accompanied by Dr. Hajah Imilia Ibrahim. During the briefing, the students were attentive and focused on what was being said. Concerning the information that was exchanged, it was necessary to inquire about it with the selected organization. Regarding their internship, the students are responsible for finding a placement for themselves. The required information, such as the name and address of the organization, should be located close to their residence. It is also essential to provide the email address, telephone number, and the name of the person in charge. The students must identify two (2) suitable organizations that could provide them with industrial training. The first organization will be the primary and most important option when applying for an internship. In contrast, the second organization will serve as a backup plan if the first application is denied or there is no reaction from the organization.

On top of that, the students were required to construct their resumes. Examples of resumes were presented to the students to give them some ideas for building their resumes. An excessive number of resume builders are available in mobile applications, including Zety Resume Builder, ResumeGenius, My Perfect Resume, Canva, VisualCV, and Resume.io. In addition, all the students were provided with a resume writing guide and a curriculum vitae guide to educate them on the significance of the content that should be included in their resumes.

Industrial training is not a new concept in the institution; nevertheless, it is an entirely new concept for students pursuing a Diploma in Information Management. For eight weeks, they will attend practical training. The students will feel excited as they learn new things outside of their classroom environment and in the real-world setting of working environments. Students can decide on the area of work they would like to pursue in their professional career throughout the time of training, known as industrial training. When they are ready, the chances and challenges that they will face will prepare them to experience the real working world. In addition to the news and concerns about industrial training, the dos and don'ts that should be followed during practical training have been discussed. During the practical training, it is hoped that the students will be able to adjust to the new experience.

What are they going to do during practical training? They will acquire knowledge through observation, the accumulation of experience, and the supervision

of the supervisor and the organization's staff. The students are expected to be ready to give their thoughts, ideas, energy, and time in any necessary manner. The faculty members desire the students to acquire new knowledge and skills during the internship. The telegram was being utilized to facilitate communication between the students and the coordinator of the industrial training program. At 4.00 pm, the briefing was concluded with a quiz designed to assess the participant's comprehension of the information presented. During one's professional journey, industrial training is not merely a phase but an experience that can completely transform one. Can the students overcome the obstacles and seize the chances that come with the internship? During the first semester of their education, we had faith that they would be able to, and we have faith in the knowledge and abilities that they have acquired. Dear students, we hope everything is going well for you, and we encourage you to put your newly acquired information to the test and improve your talents. Respect, perseverance, and discipline are essential to a successful life. Take the helm of your ship to embark on an unforgettable adventure and experience.


