Records Life Cycle

Records lifecycle refers to the stages that each record must go through and be managed during its lifespan. The lifecycle of records consists of three major stages: creation or receipt, distribution and use, and disposition.

Different policies and procedures exist at each phase.

Creation and/or Receipt

The first stage in the records lifecycle is creation. It refers to the reproduction or production of recorded or documented data. This stage begins with the creation or receipt of a record. For example, you may write a financial report (creation) or receive a memo by email (receipt).



Distribution & Use

Stage two of the records lifecycle is called "Distribution & Use". After a record is created or received, it passes through a distribution and usage phase. The distribution in the life cycle of a record includes both internal and external distribution and the impact on the entire or a portion of a business.

Disposition

The last phase of the records life cycle is the disposition and involves records retention periods being destroyed. When inactive records expire, the records life cycle comes to an end.

"UiTM Celebrates 63 Years of Excellence, Producing Impactful Graduates"



Alumni Employee Network Creation Tips

A novel strategy for longterm hiring is to use an alumni employee network. It is an online community for former workers that is either made by the business or the former workers. It can also be a helpful tool for executives and HR teams to employ as outlet of an recommendations and beneficial feedback for the business.

Firstly, identify the target demographic. When building employee an alumni network, HR leaders must bear in mind that there might not be a one-size-fits-all solution. Depending on the company, it might make greater sense to create alumni communities for particular populations, like pensioners, temporary workers, or freelancers.

Next, get executives and employees current involved. HR leaders along with everyone responsible the task should determine the amount of funds needed. necessary financing, and workers engaged in the mission before looking for executive buy-in to develop or enhance an employee alumni network. Workers who actively participate in their university's alumni associations are an ideal for this project match because they have the leadership abilities that are required from their experience in university organizations.

Another tip is make use of unofficial networks. Alumni might start their own alumni networks website like Facebook or LinkedIn in the hope to keep in touch with old coworkers. Given that those developed informal networks might not be amenable to formalization, strategy could occasionally not be successful. But at the very least, those present staff members and former workers might be prepared to join a brand-new, officially recognized employee alumni network.

University Implements Archives Record Management Sytems to Safeguard Alumni Details

User Rights

The system is designed to provide certain user rights depending on people' academic roles. This guarantees that alumni records are only accessible to authorised persons, such as alumni affairs workers and necessary administrators. The university can retain greater control over the privacy and security of alumni information by matching user permissions with organisational functions.

Access and Security

The institution places a high value on keeping alumni records secret and secure. To avoid unauthorised access or data breaches, the record management system contains strict access controls and security safeguards. These safeguards protect sensitive information like as contact information, academic records, and job history, shielding graduates from potential privacy threats.

External Access Rights:

The institution understands the value of excellent relationships with external stakeholders such as employers, partners, and funding organisations. While allowing external parties limited access to select data, the record management system guarantees stringent control over the information given. This strategy allows the institution to achieve a balance between fostering cooperation and protecting alumni privacy.

Restricted Access to data

Records holding highly sensitive or secret information, such as financial information or medical data, are designated as restricted access. Only personnel with the relevant user classification or security right may access such records, thanks to the record management system. This limitation aids in the prevention of unauthorised disclosure or abuse of sensitive alumni data.

Tracking and Accountability

the technology tracks the flow of records, allowing the institution to identify persons who have or have had custody of certain papers. This tool guarantees openness and accountability in alumni record administration, decreasing the possibility of data abuse or unauthorised use.

Comprehensive Usage Logging

The record management system records all interactions with alumni records, including access, changes, and inquiries. This degree of information offers an audit trail, allowing the institution to monitor and examine record usage, spot abnormalities, and respond to any security problems as soon as possible.

Regular Access Classification Reviews

The university is dedicated to keeping the access categories issued to alumni records relevant and accurate. Periodic evaluations are performed to verify that access permissions are current and in accordance with current rules and laws. This practise reduces the dangers connected with out-of-date access permissions and guarantees that only authorised people have access to alumni information.

PALM SUGAR WORK VISIT TO PUSA, BETONG, SARAWAK

SARAWAK, 14 JUN 2023

Universiti Teknologi MARA Sarawak Branch, in partnership with the UiTM Sarawak Branch's Business Development Unit has recognised (BDU), potential for apong sugar-based goods to be commercialised on a larger scale. Sarawak Apong Sugar, a well-known product of the state, is in the process of Geographical obtaining Indication (GI).

As a result, on June 7 and 8, 2023, a working visit was made to Kg. Sri Kalok, Pusa, Betong, Sarawak field conduct research. observations. and special discussions about sugarcane. The visit was attended by Professor Zainoren Dr. Abang Abang Abdurahman, Deputy Rector of Research and Industrial Networking of UiTM Sarawak Branch, Dr. Ahmad Fadzil Jobli, General Manager of BDU, and 9 professors who are also members of the project directed by Mrs. Junaidah Mat Jusoh.

PALM SUGAR

Mr. Juhlie @ Joblee bin Ramli, Chairman of the Darul Ulum Kalok Betong Berhad Parish Cooperative, graced the work visit in Pusa. Members of the project were given a tour of the traditional sugarcane processing area, where sugarcane is cooked over firewood. Aside from that, tour participants will be able to watch the traditional nipah roof production process, which is also being worked on by cooperative members in order to meet the demand from local residents. Following the traditional manufacturing location, the group was taken to the cooperative's Apong Sugar Processing Centre.



DETAIL >

This processing centre has been in operation for a few years, and its primary focus for the time being is on the modern processing of granulated sugar using semiautomatic processing equipment, including the use of multi-purpose cooking stoves and gas barrels as a source of fire. Modern processing, according to the cooperative, takes somewhat longer than conventional processing. The data and analysis obtained through characterization of traditional and modern processing methods, as well as the characteristics of the resulting apong sugar, are critical in identifying the unique apong sugar criteria, which is required for the GI filing process for Sarawak Apong Sugar.

In addition, the tour observes and investigates the langkau, which is the traditional location for the production of apong sugar and is generally deteriorated in terms of physical structure, building materials, and basic facilities required for future improvement efforts. This initiative is a step towards assisting entrepreneurs' economies to build and sustain the apong sugar enterprise on a global scale. In this regard, a discussion session was also held with the cooperative in order to establish an official agreement to identify apong sugar producers from the Masjid Darul Ulum Kalok Betong Berhad Parish Cooperative as participants in the Sarawak Apong Sugar Gl.




