



Her father's lineage comprises Malay and Melanau ancestry, while her mother's heritage encompasses Scottish, Iban, and Chinese roots. Presently residing in Kuching, Sarawak, Nancy is happily married with three children and she is the tenth child among eleven siblings. Following her victory in the 2008 Malaysian general election, She was graduated from Diploma in Public Administration Institute Teknologi Mara (1985), Bachelor's Degree in Law with honors in University Hull United Kingdom and Masters in Executive **Business Administration in Ohio** University in United State of America.

Nancy secured a parliamentary seat for Batang Sadong, a rural conservative constituency located in southern Sarawak state.

Demonstrating her continued popularity, she successfully defended her seat in the subsequent 2013

Malaysian general election.

Recognizing her abilities and dedication, then Prime Minister of Malaysia, Najib Razak, appointed Nancy as a Minister in the Prime Minister's Department in the newly formed Cabinet of Malaysia.



She was appointed as the Minister of **Women, Family and Community Development. Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri** from Parti Pesaka Bumiputera Bersatu Sarawak and currently holds the position of Minister of Tourism, Arts and Culture after being appointed in March 2020 as a **Member of Parliament for Batang Sadong.** She also held the portfolio of Minister of **Plantation Industry and Commodity for a** few months. In political involvement, she held the position of Assistant Secretary **General of Sarawak United Bumiputera Women's Party, Secretary of Sarawak United Bumiputera Women's Movement** and Secretary of the National Barisan Women's Movement.

A news article can include accounts of eyewitnesses to the happening event. It can contain photographs, accounts, statistics, graphs, recollections, interviews, polls, debates on the topic, etc. Headlines can be used to focus the reader's attention on a particular (or main) part of the article. The writer can also give facts and detailed information following answers to general questions like who, what, when, where, why and how.

A news article is usually on a well-defined topic or topics that are related in some way, such as a factual account of a newsworthy event. The writer is objective and shows all sides to an issue. While a good conclusion is an important ingredient for newspaper articles, the immediacy of a deadline environment means that copy editing often takes the form of deleting everything past an arbitrary point in the story corresponding to the dictates of available space on a page. Therefore, newspaper reporters are trained to write in inverted pyramid style, with all the most important information in the first paragraph or two. If the less vital details are pushed towards the end of the story, then the potentially destructive impact of draconian copy editing will be minimized.



DATO' SRI HAJAH ROHANI ABDUL KARIM





University should backup the records or data to secure the redundant storage systems, both on-site and off-site. This can be implemented by test the restoration process to verity data integrity.

RESPONSE PLAN

Response plan is an action to be taken in the situation of a data breach, system failure, any threats affecting alumni records. The university should assign roles and responsibilities, establish communication channels, and conduct simulations to ensure preparedness.

AFTER

CONTINUAL EVALUATION

The university should stay updated on emerging threats and regulatory changes that may impact data and records security. Which is by conducting periodic reviews and assessments to identify areas of improvement.



TRAINING AND AWARENESS

Provide training to the employees or stakeholders in alumni record management. Not to forget, raising awareness about the importance of records security and the role of each individual plays in maintaining Business Continuity Plan.

REGULAR MAINTENANCE

This step in the Business Continuity Plan reflects changes in technology and organizational requirements. So, the university could enhance security controls and backup processes throughout the plan.

TESTING

Testing process can test the effectiveness of a Business Continuity Plan by conducting feedback and responses to the plan. So, the university is able to learn from the test and make necessary improvements to enhance the overall flexibility of alumni record management.
